

Impact of the additional P.E funding to date.

All children from Reception through to Year 6 now benefit from at least 1 PE lesson with a specialist sports coach working alongside their own class teacher once a half term. This is in addition to the children's other weekly PE or swimming lesson. This has resulted in teachers being 'up-skilled' in their delivery of the PE curriculum whilst working alongside specialist coaches.

The funding allowed us to pay for partnership PE costs so that children can participate in inter and intra schools events. Participation in competitions held outside of school increased to 55% in KS2.

The funding enabled all the pupils to visit the Anderton Centre. The children had an amazing day of adventure. They worked collaboratively to solve problems, learnt new skills in orienteering and took to the lake to learn how to canoe.

We are proud to announce that these actions resulted in Anderton Primary School being awarded the Sainsbury's Schools Games Bronze Certificate in July 2014.

All children thoroughly enjoyed the Outdoor Week held in June 2015. All the children were able to climb a climbing wall. KS2 children enjoyed archery. All the school participated in an assault course.

The school will be in receipt of sports funding of £10,500 during 2015 – 2016, and it is anticipated that the actions taken during 2014-2015 will continue throughout this period, enabling the school to work towards the Sainsbury's Schools Games Silver Certificate.
