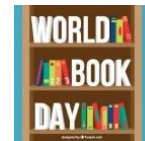

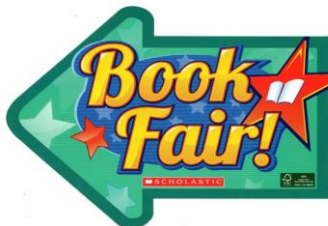

We have been awarded an amazing £631.30 to spend on books, all down to your generosity.

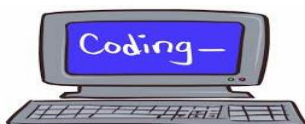
